## Paving of sections of the Barataria Extension Road and the VMCOTT Access Road

The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (NGC) reminds the public of the planned continuation of construction works on Phase 2 of its project to divert a segment of its existing 16-inch low-pressure pipeline located at Barataria Roundabout Bypass Road. NGC's 16-inch pipeline project involves upgrading services of low-pressure customers by switching to a higher-pressure pipeline operating system.

Works will continue with the paving of sections of the Barataria Extension Road and the VMCOTT Access Road as follows:

**Saturday 19th November 2022**  
**7:00 am to 5:00 pm**

Works will include the application of bituminous tack coat, placement and spreading of hot asphalt mix on the road surface, compaction and finishing of the road surface with a five-ton asphalt roller. During this period, commuters will have partial access to Barataria Roundabout Bypass Road. There will be some movement of heavy machinery.

A comprehensive traffic management plan will be implemented and the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) will be on hand to assist with traffic management with the following considerations:

- The Barataria Roundabout Bypass Road is a one-way, dual carriageway roadway, heading in an easterly direction.
- During paving works on the roadway, one lane of the dual carriageway will remain open to traffic.
- Dividers will be utilised to clearly separate the lanes on the roadway.
- There will be advance notice/signs for commuters along the roadway.

Every effort will be made to minimise inconvenience to the public. NGC wishes to assure the public that all work will be conducted with safety as its highest priority.

All activities will be conducted in accordance with NGC's Environment, Safety and Security Policies and Procedures, as well as all applicable codes and standards.
