## NGC hosts delegation from PETRONAS of Malaysia

# November 8th, 2023

NGC hosted a delegation of senior executives from PETRONAS of Malaysia, at its Orinoco House head office in Point Lisas, on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Petronas, founded in August 1974 (one year before NGC was fully incorporated), is Malaysia's state-owned energy company. With a global vision, Petronas produces and delivers energy solutions and has a global presence in over 100 countries. With a passion for delivering and optimising clean energy solutions to empower sustainable societal growth, the delegation visited Trinidad and Tobago to engage in discussions with key energy stakeholders.

Much like NGC's role as a state-owned company operating across the energy value chain, Petronas is an integrated energy company with interest in upstream exploration and production and petrochemical and LNG plants, including marketing and shipping. Malaysia maintains its position as the 5<sup>th</sup> largest LNG exporter in the world after Australia, the US, Quatar and Russia and Trinidad and Tobago follows in the 6<sup>th</sup> position. The country exports approximately 30 million tonnes (MT) of LNG per year.

Chief Operating Officer, Mr. Adnan Zainol Abidin, who also holds the position of Executive Vice President and Chief Executive Officer Gas Business, led the delegation which also consisted of other senior executives from Petronas. Members of the delegation shared their experience and key learnings with NGC during the course of the meeting. The Honourable, Stuart Young, Minister of Energy and Energy Industries, and NGC's line minister, led the Trinidad and Tobago contingent hosted at NGC, which included NGC Group Chairman, Dr. Joseph Ishmael Khan, NGC President, Mark Loquan and Permanent Secretary, Sandra Fraser and Deputy Permanent Secretary, Karinsa Tulsie.

NGC's team delivered presentations on the company's operations and technical processes and discussed opportunities in the domestic gas-based sector. PETRONAS introduced its green energy company, Gentari (formed in 2022), to the Trinidad and Tobago team. Topics discussed included Gentari's business activities in the clean energy space. The exchange was immeasurably valuable to NGC as it is in the process of not only embedding sustainability throughout all facets of the

organisation, it is also working towards incorporating a 'green company' into The NGC Group of Companies.

Commenting on the visit, Mr. Loquan noted: "We at The NGC Group are happy to have had the chance to showcase our work and services to this global energy major, and discuss potential areas of collaboration and exchange of experience that we can explore in future. We look forward to building on this and other relationships with entities across the globe, supporting our strategic growth objectives and in service of national development."
