Notably, he ceremonially opened the Savonetta Pier IV in 2000 – a state-of-the-art, multi-user petrochemical facility owned by NGC's subsidiary, National Energy Corporation of Trinidad and Tobago Limited. This pier is now part of an industrial estate serving several international customers. Train 1 of the Atlantic LNG facility in Point Fortin was also commissioned during his tenure as Prime Minister.

Mr. Panday also leaned on experience from his service as former Minister of External Affairs and International Trade to conceptualise and implement incentives that would make Trinidad and Tobago more attractive to investors.
