Notice of Pipeline Repair Works along the Priority Bus Route between Mt Lambert and the Bermudez Compound

The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (NGC) will commence repair works on its 3-inch natural gas pipeline to the Bermudez factory. The line runs east to west along the northern verge of the Priority Bus Route. The repair works will take place off the Priority Bus Route between Mt. Lambert and the Bermudez Compound.

Works include, but will not be limited to the following:

Excavation activity to unearth and repair the line.
