NGC Executes Three Gas Supply Agreements with Major Upstream Supplier Perenco

The National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (“NGC”) is pleased to announce the successful execution of three upstream gas supply agreements for gas sold from the Teak, Samaan and Poui fields (“TSP”), Block 2C and Block 3A operated by Perenco. The production from these blocks accounts for a significant percentage of upstream gas supply, thereby underscoring NGC’s contribution to securing a continued and reliable natural gas supply for Trinidad and Tobago’s domestic energy sector. NGC welcomes ongoing collaboration with upstream producers to secure all commercially viable natural gas supply.

Chairman of NGC, Gerald I. Ramdeen, commenting on NGC’s recent successes in securing additional supply of gas to the domestic market, stated:

“The execution of the GSCs signals yet again that NGC is assiduously working to secure the future of the domestic energy sector, with tangible accomplishments that serve to boost confidence in an improved outlook for the Trinidad and Tobago economy.”

Chairman Ramdeen expressed appreciation for Perenco’s commitment to engaging with NGC to establish commercially viable terms for both parties.
